Why Scrum?

Scrum teaches teams to break the product vision into smaller, manageable slices of work called "user stories" that the team can complete in short iterations. User stories span from the concept phase to the delivery of a potentially shippable product that benefits the user in the story. Scrum teams are highly productive and release a better product at a decreased project risk.

Who Should Attend

All software team members should attend this course, including project managers, team leads, development managers, product managers, architects, developers, testers, and even executives (e.g. CIOs and CTOs).

If you pass the CSM test, you will receive a CSM certificate and a two-year membership to the Scrum Alliance.
